<p>Port Security &amp; Resilience Joint Assessment Team Analysts are responsible for assessing the security and resiliency of critical ports, infrastructure, and key assets across the nation. Analyst will work in a small joint (Army and Air) team environment and will be required to analyze and write detailed reports. Interested applicants should have relatable experience in at least one of the following assessment areas:</p> <p><b>Infrastructure and Operations Analyst:</b> Analyst should possess a general familiarity with the generation and distribution capabilities with at least one of the following utilities: Natural Gas, Electric, Water, and/or Communications. Assess and characterize facility operations reliance on required infrastructure (utilities and logistics) and analyze the impact if this infrastructure was lost. Analyst will utilize documentation, interviews, and observations related to the infrastructure and utility systems required for site/facility operations.</p> <p><b>Emergency Response Analyst:</b> Analyst should possess experience in one of the following: law enforcement, firefighting, emergency medical services, and/or emergency operations center functions. Analyst will utilize documentation, interviews, and observations to write a detailed report on how multiple first responder agencies would support an all-hazards event occurring at a facility.</p> <p><b>Security and Incident Management Analyst:</b> Analyst should possess experience in one of the following: incident command system, mass notification systems, crime prevention through environmental design, intrusion detection systems, entry control procedures, perimeter design, lighting, camera systems, assault planning, law enforcement tactics, explosive detection/disposal, and intelligence dissemination. Assesses overall security operations for a facility including applicable threats and identification of vulnerabilities.</p> <p><b>Virtual Critical Asset Tour Technician:</b> Technician should have general experience in photography, associated equipment, and the integration of media into a comprehensive Adobe/HTML product. Technician should possess the ability to organize large amounts of electronic data, coordinate independent meetings, and be able to conduct aerial photography from helicopter platforms.</p> <p><b>Requirements:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Working knowledge of Microsoft Office, Adobe Acrobat, and Windows Based Operating Systems.</li><li>• Excellent verbal and written communication skills.</li><li>• Instructor Certification is desired, but not required.</li><li>• Current GOVCC in good standing due to moderate travel requirements.</li><li>• Experience in conducting interviews and organizing multi-agency meetings.</li><li>• Experience in proofreading and editing professional documents.</li></ul>
