#### **NATURE OF WORK:**

Under general supervision, at an advanced level, performs highly skilled electrical installation and maintenance work in accordance with industry standards, guidelines and applicable codes in the West Virginia Military Authority. Performs design of complex electrical work and oversight of electrical contractors. Installs, repairs, and maintains complex electrical equipment and related systems. May serve as lead worker over other electricians or other staff members. Some travel is required. Performs related work as required.

### **EXAMPLES OF WORK PERFORMED:**

- 1. Installs, repairs, renovates and maintains low and high voltage systems, HVAC, electrical equipment and related systems.
- 2. Designs electrical circuit schematic plans and writes specifications; reads blueprints and schematic diagrams and engineering specifications. Inspects electrical installations.
- 3. Locates and corrects power failures and short circuits.
- 4. Ensures lock-out, tag-out procedures are followed by electricians and contractors.
- 5. Ensures safety procedures are followed by electricians and contractors.
- 6. Ensures all operational checks and maintenance are accurately performed according to specifications.
- 7. Schedules and coordinates with Civil Engineering control office on generators and power out ages.
- 8. Maintains records and prepares reports. May serve as lead worker.
